Two construction awards for the 60-story residential tower



This month, the Concrete Industry Board awarded Millennium Tower a 2008 Roger H. Corbetta Award of Merit, while the San Francisco Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers gave it a 2008 Award for Outstanding Structural Engineering Project.

Developed by Millennium Partners, the 60-story luxury residential tower on Mission Street in San Francisco will be the tallest residential tower west of the Mississippi when it's completed in 2009.
